**30/18 To consider and respond to the St Georges Barracks consultation and associated issues:**

Consideration was given to recent correspondence from local villages, councillors and Rutland County Council. Cllr Baines was on hand to answer questions.

Council agreed unanimously to endorse and be a signatory to the paper prepared & proposed by the chair of Empingham Parish Council. This paper will be sent to the leader of Rutland County Council, Alan Duncan MP and other interested parties. The clerk will respond by 8<sup>th</sup> June 2018 to enable submission of the paper by the close of the St. Georges Barracks consultation on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

Employment  
Mineral Extraction (post extraction)  
Density of housing  
Infrastructure.

Members agreed to write to Rutland County Council to request that representatives from local villages should have voting rights on the delivery board considering the St. Georges Barracks development.

The residents of Morcott should be encouraged to respond to the consultation and various documents will be posted on the website before the next Parish Council meeting 14<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

A response from MPC will be prepared for the June meeting when further discussion will take place.
