

MORCOTT VILLAGE POLL, Thursday 7th September 2017

At the well-attended Parish Meeting on 26th July 2017, members of the electorate requested a Village Poll (or referendum) regarding the proposed refurbishment of the White Horse Inn and housing on the paddock as exhibited by Burghley Estates in July 2016.

The Village Poll will take place in the Village Hall on:

THURSDAY 7TH SEPTEMBER 2017

BETWEEN 4.PM AND 9.PM.

The Poll will be a secret ballot (just like a General Election) organised and run by Rutland County Council according to Electoral Commission regulations. Notices have been posted on both the Parish Council & Village websites and the Parish Council Notice Board.

The Question being asked of the village is:

“Do you support the current linked proposals by Burghley Estates to build houses on the Paddock including the refurbishment of The White Horse Inn?”

To ensure that Morcott Parish Council, Burghley Estates & Rutland County Council have a full understanding of how the Village feels about the proposals it is important that as many members of the electorate as possible cast their vote. Please note that there is no provision for postal and proxy votes.

To remind you of the current proposals, there will be an exhibition **on Sunday 3rd September 2017 in Morcott Village Hall between 2pm and 5pm.**
